**Temples of Abu Simbel**: The climax of the journey - Ramses II's great temple, with its four colossal 20-meter statues, and the Temple of Hathor dedicated to Nefertari, adorned with six imposing statues of the king and queen.

**Not included:** international and domestic flights, drinks, tips, and personal expenses.



#### The Temple of Kalabsha

Breakfast on board and visit to the magnificent **Temple of Kalabsha**, begun during the Ptolemaic period and completed under Emperor Augustus. Dedicated to the sun god Mandulis, it preserves Christian traces, including a Coptic cross and a relief of Saint George.

#### From Beit El Wali to Wadi El Seboua

Continue to **Beit El Wali**, Ramses II's rock-cut temple decorated with scenes of his military victories. Return for lunch, then sail toward **Wadi El Seboua**, where three temples were relocated during the construction of the Aswan High Dam.

Dinner and overnight on board.

#### Day 03 - Wadi El Seboua to Amada

#### The Temples of Wadi El Seboua

Walk along the avenue of sphinxes leading to the **Temple of Ramses II**, partly carved into the rock. Continue with a visit to the **Temple of Dakka**, dedicated to Thoth, and the **Temple of Maharraga**, unfinished and without inscriptions.

#### **Amada - The Jewel of Lake Nasser**

After lunch, sail to the **Temple of Amada**, the oldest in the region, with reliefs of exceptional beauty. Visits continue to the **Temple of Derr** and the **Tomb of Pennut**.

#### Day 04 - Amada, Qasr Ibrim & Abu Simbel

#### **Qasr Ibrim**

Sail toward **Qasr Ibrim**, the only Nubian monument still standing in its original location. Enjoy a panoramic stop to view the ruins of a city that was once a vital center in Pharaonic, Roman, and Byzantine times.

#### **Abu Simbel - The Masterpiece of Egypt**

In the afternoon, arrive at **Abu Simbel**, Egypt's most iconic site:

- **Great Temple of Ramses II**: four colossal statues, each 20 meters high, dominate the entrance.
- Temple of Hathor: six 10-meter statues depicting Ramses II and Queen Nefertari.

Dinner and overnight on board.
